Application for Proctor-in-training

Proctors-in-training, affectionately known as PIT's, shall be chosen by the Course Manager and Staff, assisted by the following guidelines and requirements:

- A PIT is a boy or girl entering grade 11, grade 12, or college in the fall of 2010
- A PIT will have participated in previous King's Courses
- A PIT will be able to demonstrate openness with adults in the Course
- A PIT will be a strong and positive role model for younger choristers
- A PIT will demonstrate a kind, helpful attitude toward younger choristers
- A PIT will exhibit an ability and willingness to work within the rules of the Course

PIT's assist Proctors during the Course. A returning PIT who is chosen to serve again in this capacity receives a \$100.00 scholarship for the year that he/she serves. PIT's who reach their 21st birthday prior to the start of the Course in a given year are eligible for consideration as a Proctor for that year.
